## **ASCE Order of the Engineer Ceremony at CPP**



On Friday May 11, 2018, the ASCE student chapter from Cal Poly Pomona hosted the annual "Order of the Engineer" ceremony. This increasingly popular event took place on the 8<sup>th</sup> floor of the CLA Building located on the campus of Cal Poly Pomona. The purpose of this ceremony aims to recognize the obligations of civil engineers and the importance of upholding those responsibilities with integrity. Inductees typically receive a steel ring for taking an oath to uphold the values of the civil engineering practice.

The event began at 6pm with the first half hour set aside for networking among everyone in attendance. Participants included students from Cal Poly Pomona, Cal Baptist University, and younger professionals from the SB/Riv section. Eligibility for Induction into the Order of the Engineer involves having satisfied one of the following requirements;

- Having graduated from an ABET-accredited engineering program, or
- Holding a license as a Professional Engineer in the U.S.
   or
- Being enrolled as a senior in an EAC of ABETaccredited engineering program and within one academic year of graduation.

The ceremony started with an introduction from Christopher Quach (ASCE SB/R YMF President) who then introduced Jerry Burke (ASCE LA Section President) as the guest speaker. After listening to a brief history of this event and recitation of the oath, participants were called up one by one to receive their ring.


